



INSPIRE Small Project Micro-Awards

Application Details & Requirements

INSPIRE is offering small project micro-awards for INSPIRE investigators with ongoing projects that require some additional funding for discrete, well-defined needs to complete the project.

Eligibility

- Researchers conducting simulation-based research in pediatrics.
- Applicants must be an INSPIRE member at the time of submission and must have presented an ALERT at an INSPIRE meeting in the last 5 years.
- Must have active IRB approval or exemption.

Conditions

- Up to \$2,000 for one year; non-renewable.
- Must show receipts or documentation to support exact budget.
- Cannot be used to provide salary support for investigator.
- No indirect costs.

Deadlines

- Application deadline **ongoing**.
- Check INSPIRE's [website](#) for submission details.

Application Requirements

- Format: Arial, 11 point, single spaced, 1-inch margins. 1-page maximum
- A completed application will include:
 1. Narrative Research Proposal (1 page)
 1. **Succinct abstract (~250 words)**: includes background, hypotheses and specific aims, study design.
 2. **Needs statement**: How will this advance the project to completion? What is the current status of your project and what have you completed to date? Who will serve as mentor, if any?
 3. **Budget** / Justification for funds (For what will they be used? Why are they needed for the project?)
 4. **Resources**: Availability of resources necessary to complete the study. What other funds / grants / awards have you gotten or tried before this?
 2. Documentation of Human Subjects approval, or exemption, or evidence of submission. *
 3. Documentation of budget items needed showing exact costs.

*These documents do not count toward the 1-page maximum.
